CAB Report:

The CAB will meet on September 14th. The draft of the meeting summary is attached to this email.

The CAB has been looking into bug tracking software and made a recommendation to NARFE National to purchase a one year subscription to help keep track of issues that NARFE IT receives, handles, and resolves. This software will be discussed at the October 12th meeting with a solution, we hope.

AMS gave us a surprise in September with the addition of an alpha-index on the Membership listing for both the Chapters and the federation. On top of that, there was a blue bar that provided a drop-down button menu so that users can select which columns of the membership roster they want to view. Not perfect for the Federation-level, but an improvement. (Federation membership list is missing a selection and there is no alpha index for the National-only membership list.

NARFE National will be upgrading their web software in October, including the NARFE-hosted websites. The new software is based on WordPress. Websites that are kept up-to-date will migrate first. Websites that are out of date may get contacted by NARFE Communications to find out why, if they need help, and how to work with the new web software. If you have a website that needs updating but are unable to do so, let me know. I can help you.

The M114 is still in process and labels may be ready to drop during October – we hope.

The CAB continues to work on changes for AMS that are field-officer user friendly. If you have questions regarding AMS, please feel free to contact me.
