NARFE Total Membership

As of April 30, 2020, total NARFE membership is **181,522** (National Only **95,081** and Chapter **86,441**, 47.1% are Chapter members. As of May 19, 2020, AMS shows Region IX has **10,486** members (National Only **5,189** & Chapter **5,297**, 50.5% are Chapter members and Washington Federation has **5,189** (National Only **2,324** & Chapter **2,704**, 53.8% are Chapter members.

Active Federal Employees

As of April 30, 2020, NARFE has 23,838 Active Federal Employees. Washington Federation has 848 Active Federal Employees.

Alzheimer's Information

As of April 30, 2020, NARFE's total contribution to Alzheimer's was **\$13,542,877.40**. During the month of April 2020, **\$14,493.76** was raised nationally by our members. No other breakdown of information is available.

NARFE-PAC

NARFE PAC - Quarter V Election Cycle (116th Congress)

NARFE-PAC contributions for the 5th quarter of the 2019-2020 election cycle amounted Nationally to **\$360,303.34** for a five quarter total of **\$1,427,546.50**. The mean contribution Nationally YTD was **\$57.01**. Through Quarter V, there were **25,040** contributors and **779** sustainers. Through Quarter V, Region IX contributions amounted to **\$63,473.20** for a mean contribution of **\$76.94**. There were **825** contributors and **70** sustainers. Washington Federation contributed **\$33,562.00** for a mean contribution of **\$75.25**. There were **446** contributors and **37** sustainers.

2019 – 2020 NARFE-PAC Distributions (Through March 31, 2020)

Susan DelBene (D, 1st) received \$1,000, Dan Newhouse (R, 4th) received \$1,000; Derek Kilmer (D, 6th) received \$10,000; Kim Shirer (R, 8th) received \$2,000; Adam Smit (D, 9th) received \$1,000 and Denny Heck (D, 10th) received \$5,000.

NARFE Email System (NES)

I don't have access to the National number of NES users. Of the **10,486** Region IX NARFE members, just **2,881** or 27.5% receive NES messages. In Washington Federation, of **5,028** members, just **1,485** or 29.5% receive NES messages.
